Winter in the Harbor

January and February in the harbor can vary between moderate rains to hot Santa Ana conditions. As a boater it is wise to be prepared for both. Here are some tips for preparing your boat:

- Make sure to secure your canvas and rigging. Failing to do so is dangerous and could damage your vessel.
- Make sure your mooring lines are in good condition and are secure.
- Inspect your batteries and bilge pumps to ensure they are in good working order.

Marina Rule Reminders

- Nothing may be stowed on the dock except for dock steps and in the dock box provided (rule 20)
- BBQs and refueling at dock side are prohibited (rule 12)
- Cleaning fish and fishing are not allowed in the marina (rules 5 & 40)
- Children under 12 are not allowed on the docks without a parent or responsible adult (rule 9)
