Security Tips

- Keep dock gates secure at all times...ALL TIMES!
- If you see something suspicious call the Harbor Patrol immediately. Better safe than sorry. Harbor Patrol can be reached at (949) 248-2222 or (949) 723-1002.
- Don't leave a key to your cabin hidden on your boat...crooks know that trick.
- Report security issues to the Marina...but call the Harbor Patrol FIRST.

Marina Rule Reminders

- Do not toss cut bait in the water or clean fish at dock side. It creates a nuisance by attracting birds and sea lions. (Rule 40).
- No trailers or RVs are allowed in Marina parking lots. (Rule 33).
- Vehicles may not be stored in marina lots for longer than 72 hours. If you need more than 72 hours, please let the marina office know. (Rule 33).
- Dock steps may not be used for storage. (Rule 20)

Avoiding the US Coast Guard Vessel Documentation Scam

We have been hearing about some US Vessel Documentation scams going around where companies offer to "assist" with the documentation process. This "assistance" ends up costing the boat owner several times the normal fees.

If you are looking for a reliable vessel documenting agency, the Marina office can provide information on a couple of local companies that have been in the business for 30+ years.
