



Dana Point Marina Company Live-Aboard Permit Requirements

- What constitutes “Living Aboard”?

Occupancy of the Vessel for periods in excess of (a) 48 hours in any seven day period or (b) three (3) weeks of vacation per calendar year shall be regarded as “living aboard,” (except for major holidays).

- Vessel must occupy a minimum 35’ slip and be at least 34’ length overall.
- Only Tenant of Record may live-aboard vessel.
- Tenant must provide proof of \$1 million general liability insurance, naming the Dana Point Marina Company and the County of Orange as additionally insured.
- Submit a current Coast Guard Seal of Safety Checklist.
- Complete a Live-Aboard Permit agreement and pay an additional security deposit.
- Live-aboard permit fees are 40% of basic slip rent.
